Prizes	1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will receive medals. The five top-scoring teams based on scoring will receive a cup. Prize money awarded for the best 3 teams based on scoring. In case of several teams' equal score the prize money is awarded based on the overall ranking (statistics of medals). 1st place: €750, 2nd place: €450, 3rd place: €300	
Scoring system	Each team gets 1 point per competitor (up to a maximum of 50 points) and for each: 1 st place +6 points / 2 nd place +4 points / 3 rd place +3 points / 4 th and 5 th place +2 points / 7 th place +1 point	If there is only one competitor in a weight-class he/she is awarded the score and medal of that class, unless he/she competes in the next higher weight-class.
Competition mode	2 participants: Best of 3 (2-times winning is necessary for the 1 st place) 3-5 participants: Round Robin (Pool-System) starting from 6 participants: Knockout system with double repechage	
Competition rules	IJF (International Judo Federation) / ÖJV (Austrian Judo Association), arm lock- and strangling techniques allowed in all categories, at U14-category: IPPON when visible effective. U14+U16: No limits regarding the colour of kimono, U18+U23: white and blue kimono required!	
Winner ceremony	After end of each weight category, U18+U23 white kimono required! Prize money und cups for the best teams will be awarded after the final winner ceremony on Sunday, February 23rd, 2024
